

Session 2: Make a wind sock

In this session, we are going to make a decorated wind sock that you can hang up outside (or blow through with a hairdryer!) to see the ribbons wave in the wind. It can help you to remember the storm that Jesus and his friends were in...and that even the wind and waves obey Jesus (as we will see in Session 3!).

You will need:

- A tube that is open at both ends (kitchen roll / pringles tube / make your own tube from some card and tape)
- Decorations (stickers / pens / stamps / glitter)
- Ribbons (cut up strips of thin paper, fabric etc)
- Tape and glue stick
- A small amount of string (around 15cm)

Instructions:

- Start by decorating your tube. You could wrap it in plain or coloured paper, then add decorations and drawings.
- Cut out and add on the label below.
- Cut lots of ribbons, and tape them to the inside of your tube so that they hang down from the bottom of the tube.
- Tape the ends of the string to two points on the top of the tube to create a hanging loop
- Hang your wind sock somewhere and wait for some wind!
